Arrival instructions

Your experience begins at 1:45pm. The Safari Park opens at 10am, and you're welcome to arrive anytime from then. To ensure a smooth check-in process please arrive by 1:15pm at the latest. Drive straight up to the Ticket Office and let our team member know that you are here for a Behind the Scenes Bird of Prey Experience. Bring your ticket with you as this is scanned on arrival.

We recommend that you park in the main car park.

A member of the Education team will meet you by the vulture wings photo opportunity at the entrance to the Birds of Prey section.

Itinerary

1.45pm-2:00pm: Read and sign our safety disclaimer. Health and safety briefing from the Birds of Prey Keeper team.

2.00pm – 2.10pm: Enjoy watching our Bird of Prey Display.

2:10pm - 2:20pm: Fly our hooded vulture as part of the Bird of Prey Display.

2.20 – 2.30pm: Bird of Prey display concludes and a chance for any questions.

2.30pm: After your experience ends you are welcome to spend the rest of the day at the Safari Park. Here's some information to help you [plan your visit](#).

Please note:

- The itinerary may change due to animal welfare, weather or health reasons.
- Participants must be 16 years or over.
- This activity is not suitable for pregnant women and women who have given birth within the last six months.
- This experience takes place outdoors, we advise wearing warm layers with a waterproof jacket where appropriate.
- If you keep/work with poultry or any other birds, please contact us before your visit. This helps us take the necessary precautions to ensure the safety and wellbeing of both your birds and ours.
- If you have any accessibility needs, require additional support, or have allergies, please let us know in advance.
